Liberty Children's Art Project (LCAP) was created by artist, Marilyn Mutch in 1995 through a start-up grant from the W.K. Kellogg foundation. In the past LCAP rented a building in Negaunee, MI which offered art enrichment classes in house as well as collaborating with area schools and other like-minded organizations. In 2006, Marilyn Mutch retired and turned the executive directorship over to Carol Phillips. With the idea of low overhead costs with funds going to programs instead of space rental, the operation was moved to Powell Township School in Big Bay, MI where it is currently housed in-kind. At this time LCAP successfully works in the Greater Marquette and Alger County area schools with plans of expanding programs and collaborators in the future. LCAP is now funded through state and corporation grants, community and private foundations, fundraising events, some student tuition and private donations.
